We are a group of year 5 students who will be reporting, interviewing and capturing the news as it happens! Here is a little bit more information so that you can get to know each and every one of us.



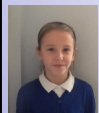
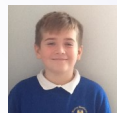
Hi I'm Marshal, I play Rugby for Morley and my favourite colour is blue and red! My favourite food is pizza and my favourite band is One Direction.
