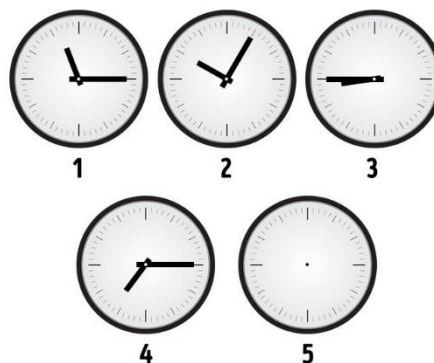
Bagels:
