Confirmed Trip to Abbey House Museum

I am writing with exciting news! Year 1's first trip is to go ahead on Thursday 18 November. We will be taking the children to Abbey House Museum in Kirkstall. As mentioned in the previous letter the children will participate in an interactive workshop looking at toys through time which links to their current history topic. They will also be able to explore the Victorian themed street and shop to help them understand what life was like as a Victorian child.

The children will be taken by coach and arrive back before the end of the school day. On the day please make sure your child is dressed in full uniform. Please ensure that your child brings a coat to school as they will be walking from the coach to the museum.

If you have chosen to provide a packed lunch for your child, please clearly label with your child's name. All children will need to bring their own drink in a plastic bottle (non- fizzy).

As we already have your completed slip for the trip, confirming you consent for your child to attend, we only require the payment of £5.00. **Please note if payment is not received from parents/carers prior to the visit, your child will not be able to go.**

We now ask that you kindly log onto the secure ParentPay system and make the payment of £5.00, which includes entrance, workshop, lunch and return coach travel and has been heavily subsidised by school.
