Dear Families,

Confirmed Trip to Cannon Hall Farm

I am writing to confirm Reception's school trip to Cannon Hall Farm on **Wednesday 22 June**. As mentioned previously, the children will be treated to a guided tour of the farm where they will learn about how the animals are cared for. They will have the opportunity to feed the animals via the tube feeders and stroke the small animals in the petting area. During the day there will also be opportunities for the children to see other events and activities taking place within the farm. The children will leave school at 9:30am and arrive back before the end of the school day.

Please dress your child in their PE kit (blue or black shorts/trousers, white t-shirt and a blue or black jumper), with trainers. We also advise a sun hat and named sun cream, along with a coat/jacket, as we can never predict the British weather! Your child will be responsible for all items brought on the trip, so a rucksack clearly labelled with their name, would be appropriate.

As this is a full day trip, please remember to send your child with two drinks in plastic bottles, (non-fizzy and no cans or glass bottles please). The school will provide your child with a healthy packed lunch. If you have opted to provide your child with their own lunch which they will take with them on the visit, **please ensure your packed lunch does not contain nuts or food products that contain traces of nuts**. All packed lunches need to be clearly labelled with your child's name.

As we already have your completed slip for the trip, confirming you consent for your child to attend, we only require the payment of £13.50. **Please note if payment is not received from parents/carers prior to the visit, your child will not be able to attend.**

We now ask that you kindly log onto the secure ParentPay system and make the payment of £13.50, which includes cost of transport and entry to Cannon Hall farm. Please make this payment by no later than **Friday 20 May**. If you are unable to log in to ParentPay please visit the school reception office and ask for Mrs Tonner who will be able to provide you with your log in details.

Should you have any questions about the trip please do not hesitate to ask either myself or your child's class teacher.

We are sure that the children will have an amazing time learning all about farm animals.
