Dear families,

I am writing with exciting news! The Year 4 trip to Magna is to go ahead on **Thursday 19 May 2022**. As mentioned in the previous letter this is an excellent opportunity for the children to further develop their understanding of states of matter, through investigating the themes of air, earth, fire and water. The children will develop their scientific enquiry skills through a wide range of hands-on activities including practical investigations and interactive pavilions. They will also explore how sound is made, linking with our next science topic, through engaging science demonstrations and their own exploration of the exhibits.

The children will be taken by coach and arrive back before the end of the school day (traffic permitting) they will be accompanied by staff from our school at all times. Children will need to be in full school uniform and be dropped off and collected from school at the normal school times.

As we will be out of school for the day, children will need to bring a **healthy** packed lunch along with two drinks (**no cans or glass bottles**). **Please ensure your child's packed lunch does not contain nuts or food products that contain traces of nuts.** All packed lunches need to be clearly labelled with your child's name. If your child receives a free school meal, they will be provided with a packed lunch, please also provide your child with two drinks.

As we already have your completed slip for the trip, confirming you consent for your child to attend, we only require the payment of £13.50. **Please note if payment is not received from parents/carers prior to the visit, your child will not be able to attend.**

We now ask that you kindly log onto the secure ParentPay system and make the payment of £13.50 which includes cost of transport, entry to Magna and the educational workshops. The trip has been subsidised by school, to make it as affordable as possible. Please make this payment by no later than **Wednesday 11 May**. If you are unable to log on to ParentPay please visit the school reception and ask for Mrs Tonner, who will be able to provide you with your log in details.

We are sure that the children will have an amazing time, as this will be a lovely experience for them!
