



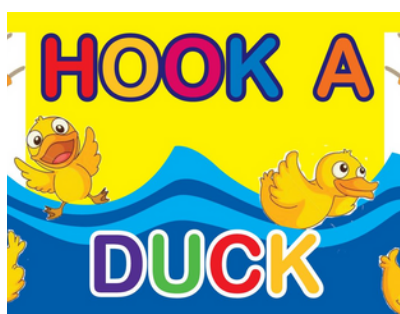
Non-uniform day
