Confirmed Year 2 trip to Yorkshire Wildlife Park

I am writing with exciting news! The Year 2 trip to Yorkshire Wildlife Park is to go ahead on **Wednesday 29 March 2023**. The children will explore the park and see a range of different animals. They will take part in an educational session, learning about food chains and the diet of a range of animals. The children will be taken by coach and arrive back before the end of the school day (traffic permitting).

Your child will receive a school packed lunch, unless you have opted to provide a packed lunch for your child. All children will need to bring two drinks in plastic bottles, (non-fizzy and no cans or glass bottles please). **Please ensure your child's packed lunch does not contain nuts or food products that contain traces of nuts.**

Children can wear their own clothes; we suggest warm clothing and suitable footwear along with a waterproof coat or jacket in case of wet weather, as we will be outside most of the day. Your child will be responsible for all items brought on the trip, including their lunch, so we would advise your child takes a rucksack.

As we already have your completed slip for the trip, confirming you consent for your child to attend, we only require the contribution of £16.00. This includes cost of transport, entry to the park and the educational workshop. The trip has been subsidised by school, to make it as affordable as possible.

We now ask that you kindly log onto the secure ParentPay system and the make contribution, please make this payment by no later than **Wednesday 01 March 2023**. **Please note the contribution is required prior to the visit.**

If you are unable to log on to ParentPay please visit the school reception and ask for Mrs Tonner, who will be able to provide you with your log in details.

We are sure that the children will have an amazing time, as this will be will be a lovely experience for them!
