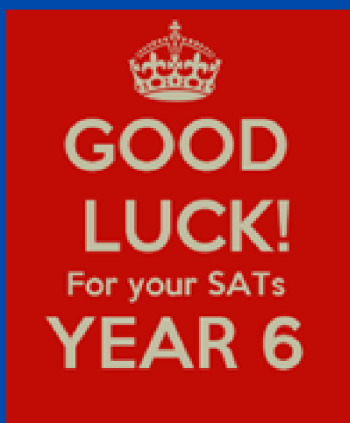
This week many of our children in Year 5 have been taking part in their residential at PGL.
